

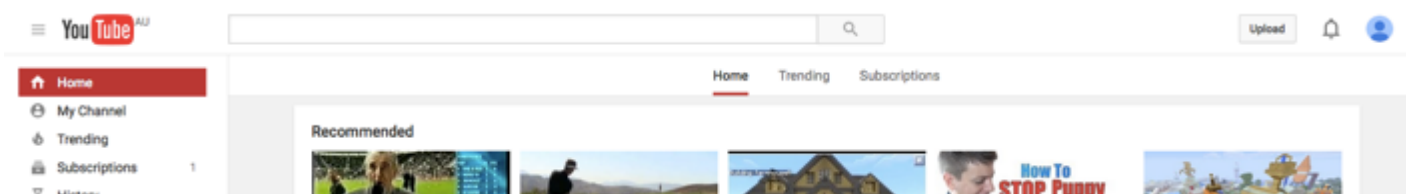
# Uploading Videos Using YouTube

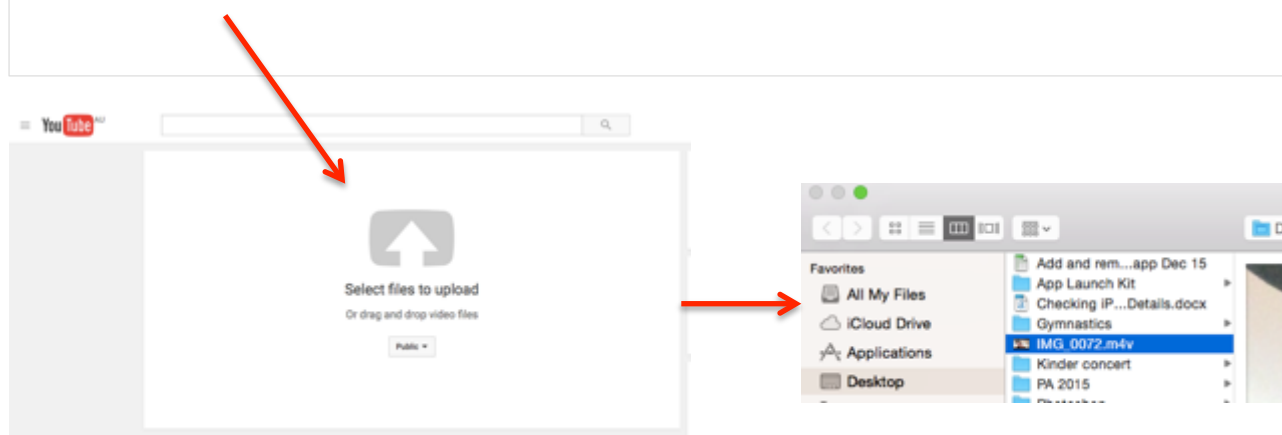

1. Assuming that you already have a You Tube account – login and upload the video you wish to display on your site. Depending on the size of your video and the speed of your internet connection, upload times may vary. This five minute video took approximately 12 minutes to upload.

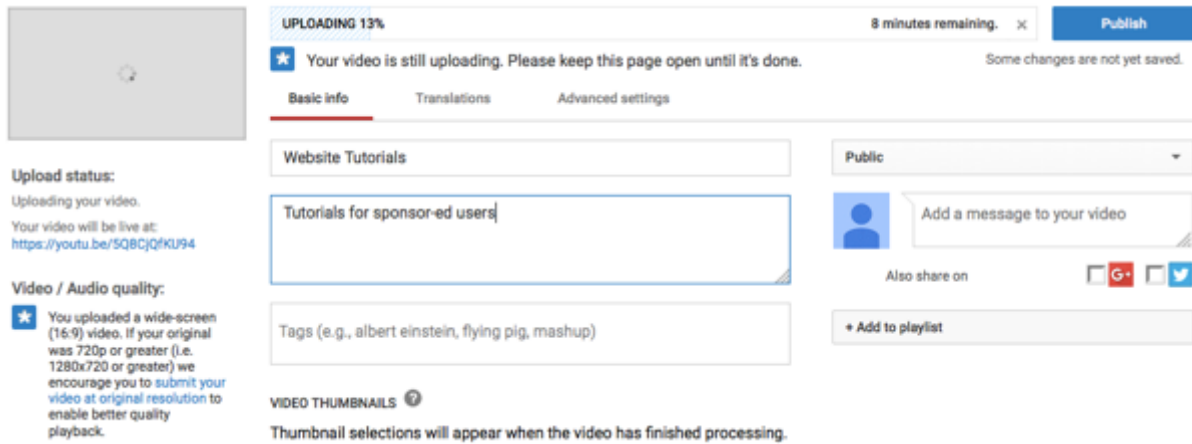


2. Click in the box to browse your computer for the video you wish to upload.

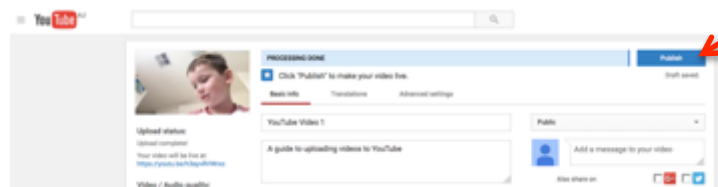

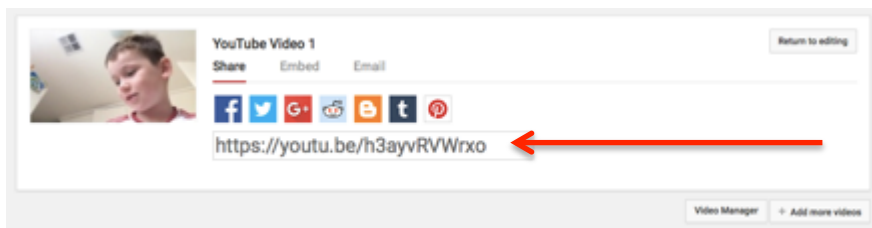
3. While waiting for your video to upload, you can fill out the title and description.



4. When your video is ready you will get this message, you need to click on **Publish**.



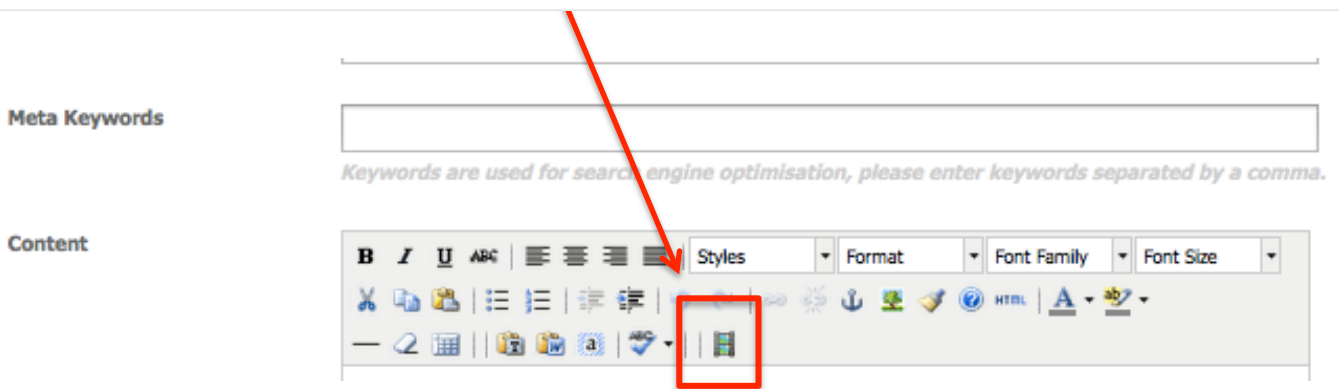
5. Copy the link that appears under SHARE



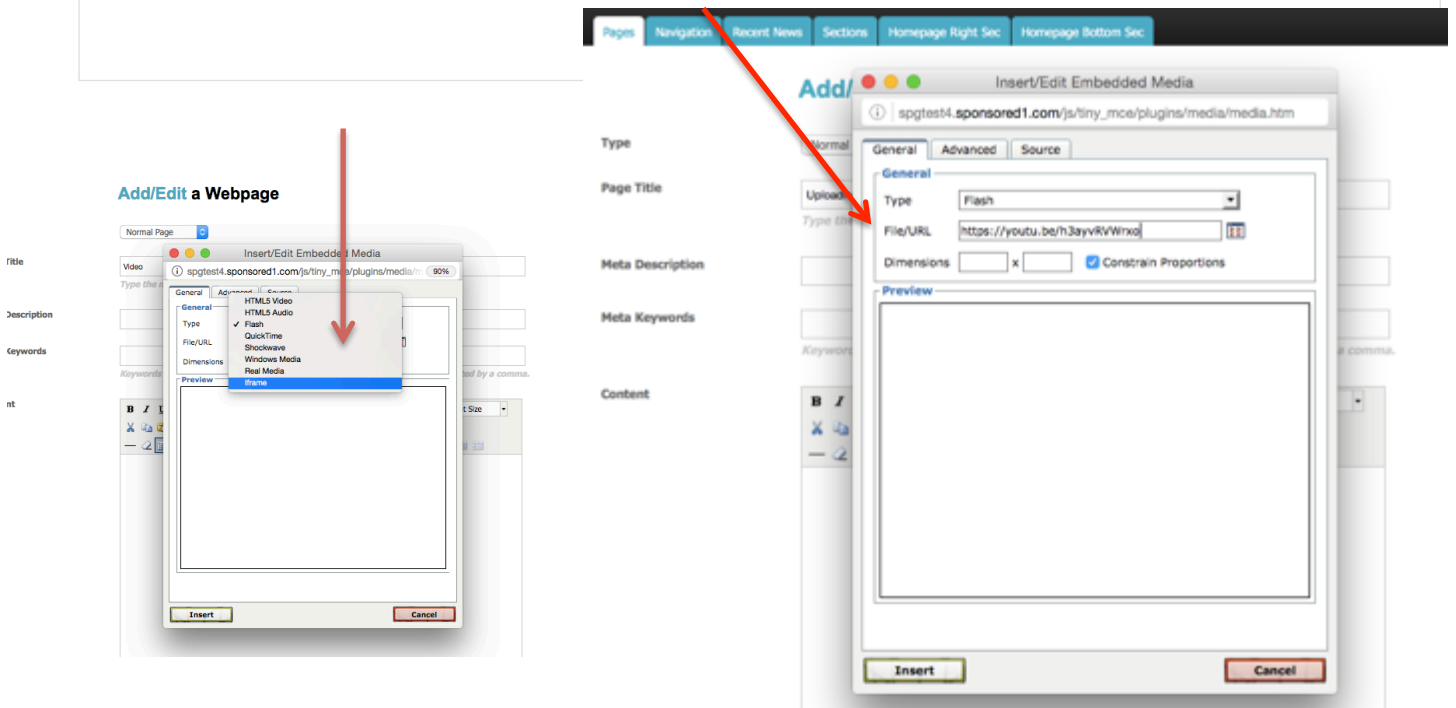

6. Open the CMS of your website. Go to the page where you would like to house the video and click on the pencil icon to edit the page.

7. In the toolbar you will see a film reel icon. Click on this.



8. Make sure the TYPE is set to iframe.  
Paste the copied link into the **File/URL** box and click **Insert**. **Note:** You can change the dimensions of the video in this screen also.
