


Print to PDF Newsletter

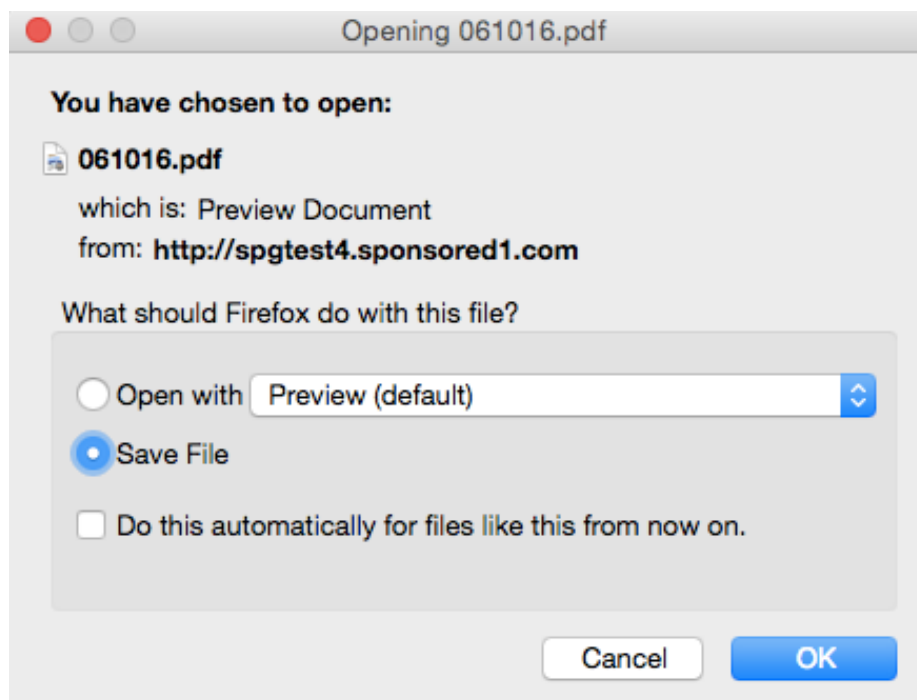
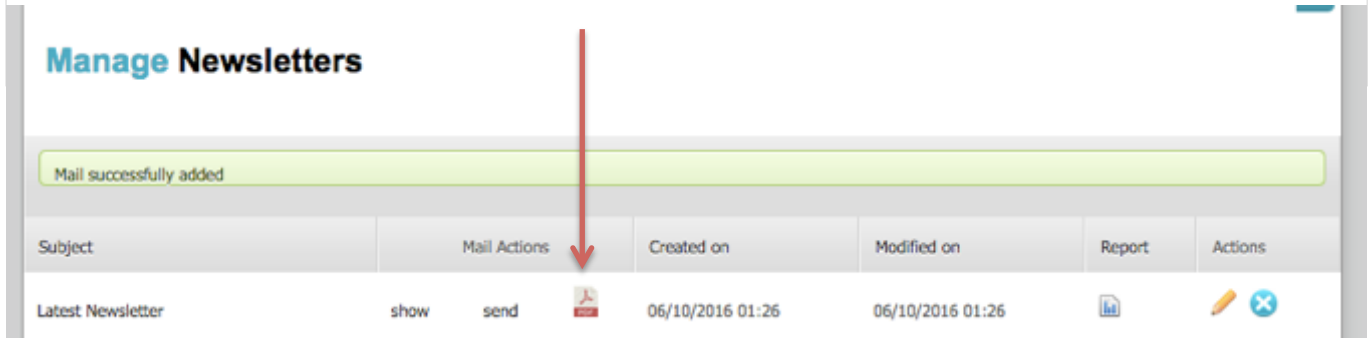
