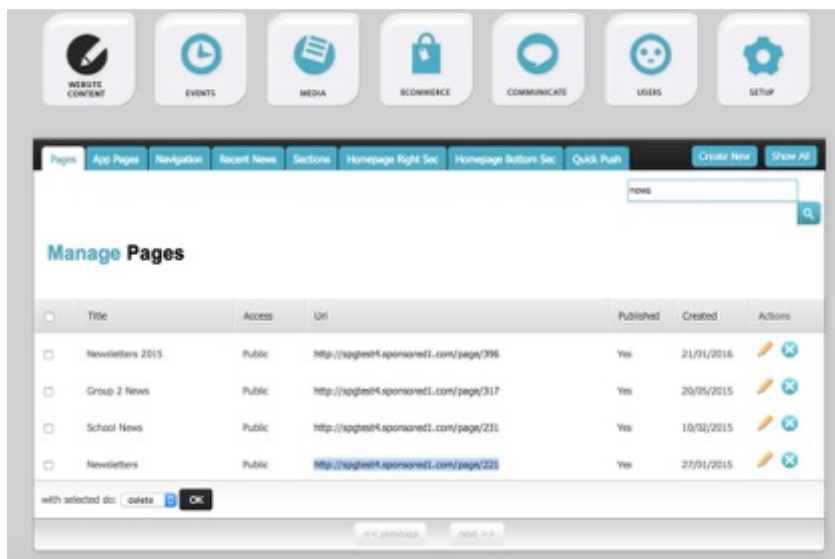

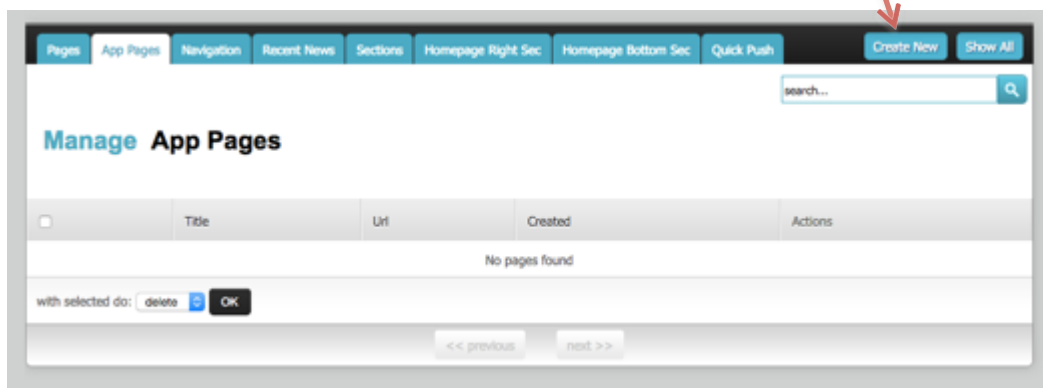
1. Firstly – download a set of our Updat-ed App Icons here: <http://sponsor-ed.com.au/page/250/Updat-ed-App-Icons>

2. WEBSITE CONTENT – Pages

Find the page you wish to link to your app --- highlight and copy the URL.




3. Go to: WEBSITE CONTENT – APP Pages – click on CREATE NEW.

4. Give your page a title and paste the URL that you copied into the PAGE URL box.
